How it works

They will help you to identify key areas for inclusion and the usefulness of an accurate SAR to support your continuing quality cycle, as well as its relevance during Ofsted inspections. Your adviser will challenge you to make substantive judgements about your provision, provide structure to the SAR, offer evidence of the impact of both the identified strengths and areas for improvement and demonstrate how you plan to address these points.

Following your coaching session, our team will read your amended SAR critically to ensure that it focuses on the learner and provides governors, senior leaders and managers, and other interested parties with an honest, accurate assessment of your delivery over the preceding year. The team will test your report against the EIF to ensure that it reflects the key areas of strength and areas for improvement, as well as the impact of your previous actions on the learners' experience, progress and success.
